ABAC 2013 Theme

The ABAC 2013 theme is Strengthening partnership: Expanding the gains of growth. Subthemes will be *strengthening regional* resilience and integration to support global growth, as well as *strengthening economic structure to achieve balanced, inclusive and sustainable* growth.

Key priority areas will be: accelerating regional economic integration, promoting sustainable development, fostering SMME development & entrepreneurship, as well as strengthening and promoting the integration of financial markets.
