## National Center for APEC Applauds Administration's Decision to Name San Francisco, California as Host City of the 3rd Senior Officials' and Related Meetings in 2011

Washington, DC (September 14, 2010) – The APEC 2011 USA Host Committee today applauded the Administration's selection of San Francisco, California as the host city for the 3rd Senior Officials' and Related Meetings in 2011. "The APEC 2011 USA Host Committee looks forward to working with the City of San Francisco, the Government of California as well as the business leaders from the San Francisco Bay Area that have worked tirelessly to create a constituency for APEC in the State of California." said Monica Whaley, President of the U.S. National Center for Asia-Pacific Cooperation, lead organization for the APEC 2011 USA Host Committee. "Our close collaboration with all of these groups will provide high quality opportunities for the private sector to engage with the APEC Senior Officials, and ensure the successful hosting of APEC in 2011."

APEC 2011 will be used to continue the advancement of the Asia-Pacific trade agenda and is a key element to strengthening the economic recovery here in the U.S. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Senior Officials' Meeting in San Francisco will be one of the most important events in the 2011 APEC calendar, laying the foundation for the APEC Ministerial and Leaders' Meetings, which will be held in Honolulu, HI in November, 2011. The San Francisco meetings will include the Senior Officials' Meeting, a high-level joint meeting of energy and transportation officials, working group and committee meetings on a range of APEC issues, as well as a series of public-private workshops that will engage senior government and private sector leaders.
