
## Security Briefing:

- 1. If your security person is badged as a Staffer but needs overpass standing access to the delegate floor, please let me know if you have not already done so. Note that for many sessions, Staffers will have access to the plenary hall on the upper levels.
- 2. There shall be absolutely no weapons allowed inside the secured perimeter.
- 3. Private vehicles/Parking: please refer to the section in the sponsor update email.
- 4. There will be an on-site medic office.
- 5. Sponsor VIPs will have access to the VIP lounge but security will need to stand outside of the lounge.
- 6. Sponsor VIPs will have private access to the plenary hall this entrance will be located outside of the VIP lounge and VIPs will enter the hall near the front rows.
- 7. There will be ambulances and fire trucks stationed at the venue in case of emergency.
- 8. There are several nearby hospitals and I would urge you to research independently which one would best fit your requirements in case of emergency.
- 9. Below is a map of the area and a list of some of the hotels where sponsors are staying. The venue itself is circled in red.



- 10. During the dates of the Summit, Peru has called a national holiday which will ease traffic.
- 11. There will be magnetometers at the entrance of the venue.
- 12. When high-profile leaders are speaking, there may also be magnetometers at the entrance to the plenary hall.
- 13. The Media Center is located mere feet from the entrance to the Summit Venue.

Please note that there are 21 World Leaders present within the security perimeter and standard precautions are in place which include sealing of pipes, re-routing of trains and traffic, erected perimeters, etc., etc.
